Active Travel Fund 4: Villa Road, Stanway – New Zebra Crossing – Advance Works

The Safer Greener Healthier team at Essex County Council want to encourage as many children as possible - as well as their parents/carers - to walk, cycle or scoot to school. Not only will this help with congestion and air quality by reducing emissions - it will also help improve our children's mental and physical health.

I am therefore writing to let you know that as part of our Healthy School Street initiative; some initial works (electrical supplies and connections) are planned to take place shortly, to facilitate the future construction of a new Zebra crossing being installed outside Stanway Primary School. These advanced works are scheduled for construction during 28th October – 1 November 2024 (school half-term week). The works are expected to take 2-3 days during this window and will require a road closure with local diversion route in order to be undertaken safely. The remaining works for the Zebra crossing are scheduled for February half-term 2025, which will also include associated carriageway resurfacing.

We appreciate that there will be some inconvenience resulting from the works, however, please bear with us as this will enable the contractor to complete the works as quickly and safely as possible.
