Summer Clubs

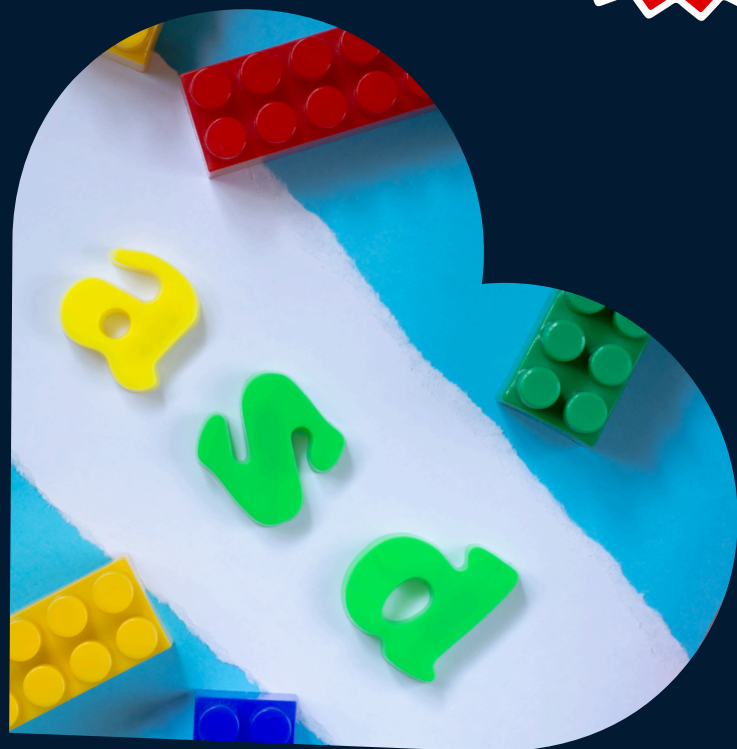
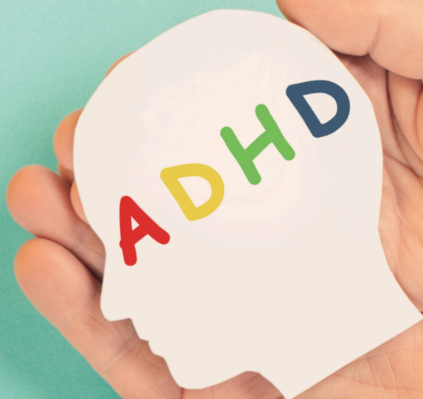
