We are delighted to have been given another opportunity to take part in the University of Birmingham research programme whereby children can be tested to assess their risk of getting Type 1 diabetes. If you would like your child to take part please see the attached letter to register as places are limited.

Heath and Safety

When dropping off and collecting children from the Reception gate the play equipment on the field should not be used and older siblings should not be entering the school via the school field.

School Uniform Reminder

We would like to remind parents of the School Uniform expectations.

Summer Term

Grey or black shorts or a blue gingham dress may be worn.

Dark grey, black or white socks

Black sensible flat or low-heeled shoes (not trainers or boots)

Sensible closed-toe sandals may be worn with socks.

Jewellery

Researchers at the University of Birmingham are conducting the ELSA study. We are writing to you because as a parent/carer of a child aged 3-13 years, your child is invited to take part.

The ELSA study is screening children, aged 3-13 years to find out their risk of getting type 1 diabetes. This is a simple finger stick blood test; we are offering the screening at your child's school on: 24th June 2025.

Children at high risk can be monitored and could enter research studies aiming to delay the start of type 1 diabetes. Every family who takes part in the ELSA study is helping us to understand more about type 1 diabetes.

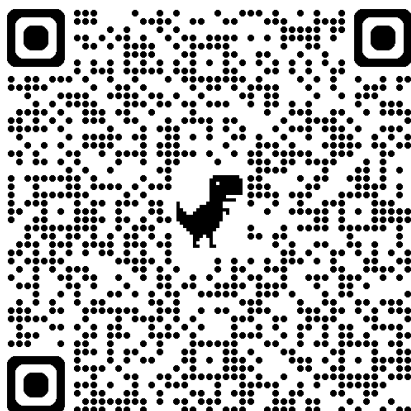
The survey includes questions about:

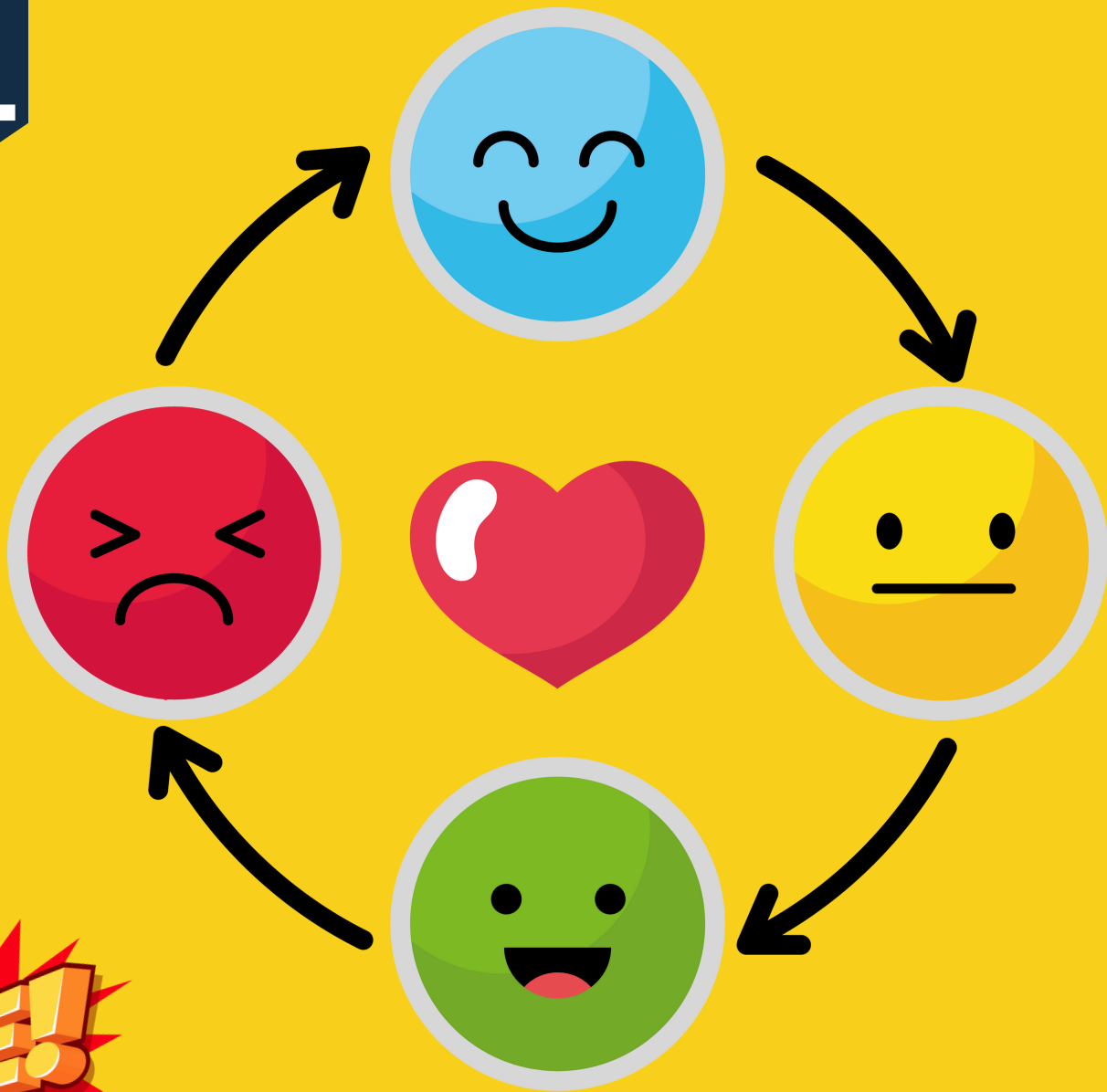

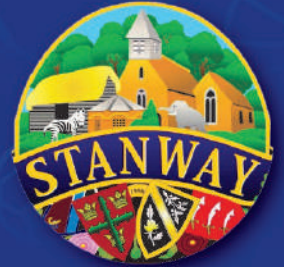
